Personal & Social Development Sex Education - Year 8

As part of the RSE curriculum at Haileybury Turnford, Year 8 students will be partaking in sex education lessons commencing from April, summer term.

Sex education lessons will provide our students with the provision of information about bodily development, sex, sexuality, and relationships, along with skills-building to help young people communicate about and make informed decisions regarding sex and their sexual health.

The objective of sex and relationship education is to help and support young people through their physical, emotional and moral development. The lessons will aim to help young people learn to respect themselves and others and move with confidence from childhood through adolescence into adulthood. Sex education plays an important role, alongside other aspects of the curriculum and school life, in helping students deal with difficult moral and social questions.

Some of the topics that will be covered this term include:

- Physical and emotional changes during puberty
- Social and emotional issues that teenagers may encounter during puberty
- Sexual orientation and gender identity
- Healthy relationships, including respect for others and sexual harassment
- Issues around consent, the law and social media

The lessons have been specifically designed by leading, national experts at the Sex Education Forum who have extensive experience in teaching sex and meet government legislation on Sex and Relationships Education (SRE). We believe these are valuable lessons planned by staff that have completed intensive training.
